## Breakfast

### **Charlotte – bread and wine – two nice fashionable places**

Plac Zbawiciela (al. Wyzwolenia) and Plac Grzybowski 2

Breakfast all day long, French style bakery, top rated and very popular

### **Butkę przez Bibułę**

Ul. Zgoda 3

Tasty soups, bagels, sandwiches and salads

### **Berek Shipudei**

Ul. Jasna 24

Hot ambience of Tel Aviv. Kitchen open until midnight

### **Beirut Hummus & Music Bar**

Ul. Poznańska 12

### **Tel Aviv**

Ul. Poznańska 11, just opposite Beirut

Vegan and vegetarian food

## Coffee and pastry

### **Słodki Słony**

Ul. Mokotowska 45

A place owned by Magda Gessler, a famous Polish cook, with delicious pastries

### **Pijalnia Czekolady E. Wedel**

Ul. Szpitalna 8

One of the most popular chocolate manufacturers, they serve delicious hot chocolate with various flavours as well as pastries and pralines

### **Odette and Odette Tea Rooms**

Ul. Górskiego 6 and Ul. Twarda 4

Fancy cakes, astonishing in their shapes, colours and tastes. The way it is furnished is an art itself, unique in Warsaw and very trendy

### **Vincent Boulangerie & Patisserie**

Ul. Chmielna 21, ul. Nowy Świat 64

Great place, delicious freshly baked baguettes, pastries and wine

### **Green Caffè Nero**

Popular chain of coffee shops with delicious coffee, sandwiches and pastry

### **Blikle Cafe**

Nowy Świat 35

Old traditional café with pastries

### **Coffee Karma**

Plac Zbawiciela 3/5

This coffee shop roasts their own coffee beans, so their coffee is probably the best in the city

### **Cukiernia Pawłowicz**

Ul. Chmielna 13

Great polish donuts served hot. This place does not offer any sitting options but it is worth trying during a stroll through the city centre

## **Lunch places (good food, interesting architecture and design)**

### **Hala Koszyki**

Ul. Koszykowa 63

19 nice restaurants in one place - an old market hall in the centre, beautifully refurbished

### **Hala Gwardii**

Plac Żelaznej Bramy 1

Lots of small restaurants in one place, open from Friday to Sunday

### **Bar mleczny Bambino (“milk bar”)**

Ul. Hoża 19 - entry from ul. Krucza

“Nostalgic” place for proper meal, the relic of the communist past where food based on milk and flour was served. The cheapest way to try Polish cuisine - menu in English available at the cash desk

## **Restaurants**

### **Restauracja Polka**

Ul. Świętojańska 2

A restaurant in the Old Town run by famous Polish cook Magda Gessler. You can try Polish traditional dishes in there

### **Opasły Tom**

Ul. Foksal 17

One of a few restaurants run by family Kręgliński. This restaurant is located in the former premises of a publishing company, with original cuisine of inventive nature “author’s cuisine”

### **Stixx Bar & Grill**

Plac Europejski 4A

Delicious food and drinks

### **UkiUki**

Ul. Krucza 23/31

Great Japanese place in Warsaw. Famous for its ramen and udon noodles and the best matcha ice-cream

### **OTO! Sushi**

Ul. Nowy Świat 46

The best sushi in Warsaw

### **Sketch**

Plac Marszałka Józefa Piłsudskiego 9

This restaurant is located at the back of Warsaw’s Opera house, great place to go after a show. Kitchen open till late!

### **Berek Shipudei**

Ul. Jasna 24

Lively colourful restaurant, crowded and nice, all day long. Kitchen open until midnight

Nice selection of places around Żurawia Street: **Butchery and Wine, Żurawina, Silk and Spicy:** Steaks, Thai Cuisine and many other

## Wine and Beer

A lot of small and various places around **Plac Zbawiciela**

**Kieliszki (“wine glasses”):** Ul. Próżna 12 and ul. Hoża 41

Small place to eat nicely and drink good wine to accompany it or separately

**Hala Koszyki:** Ul. Koszykowa 63

**Kameralna:** Ul. Foksal 11

Lots of freshly locally brewed beers, Fridays and Saturdays there is also a possibility to dance, a place with climate, funny for its interior design and menu

**Kompania Piwna Podwale 25, Bazyliszek**

(Old Town Square)

**Szwejk**

Plac Konstytucji

Place for big meals and large beers

## Drinks and Cocktail Bars

**Cocktail Bar Max & Dom Whisky:** Ul. Krucza 16/22

Lively place with comfortable seats, recommended as the best place for drinks in Warsaw, colourful drinks with fresh fruits

**Weles Cocktail Bar:** Ul. Nowogrodzka 11

Secretly hidden – unmarked, place for connoisseurs

**Pies czy suka:** Ul. Szpitalna 8a

Fancy cocktails

**Hala Koszyki:** Ul. Koszykowa 63

Lots of small restaurants in one place, with a large bar in the middle, open until late, lively and colourful

**All around Foksal street and Plac Zbawiciela or Poznańska**
