- Unlimited in time
- Consultation itself

*invoices are not covered

Prohibition to evoke advocate's testimony as evidence – aiming at revealing knowledge within the professional duties

- Right to refuse answers to particular questions

 - * art. 73 Prosecutor's decision
 - Temporary arrested
 - · Strongly justifed case

 - · Contact in prosecutor's presence
 - · Corespondence control
 - · 14 days

180 §2 Criminal Proceedings

 - Necessary for the "interest (good) of justice"
 - $\,{}^{\circ}$ Facts cannot be established in any other way
