Legal environment

Bilateral treaties and other regulations

- ECJ (Grand Chamber) Opinion 1/13 14.10.2014
- Exclusive EU competence (TFEU 3. and 81.)
- Decree no. 38 of 1958 between the USSR and Hungary



Laws in Hungary

- Civil Code: Act V of 2013
- Law favours joint-custody (co-parenting) in theory
- Practically depends on the parents' say



More laws in Hungary

- Determining the location of child
- Essential even for parents without custodian rights
- Parents urged to look for amicable ways



Breaking the law \rightarrow removal

- Wrongful removal shall not stand
- Applicants to seek help of Central Authority (CA to aid applicant)
- Applicants to seek for the summary return of child
- CA to forward application to target country's CA under the 80 Hague
- Hoping for return



Abiding the law → relocation

- Proceeding to issue by applicant
- Environmental check 🛭
- Schooling resolved 🗹
- Income ensured

 ✓
- Authority decision to substitute other parent's consent

Relocation dilemmas

- Proceeding formal or not?
- Deepness of investigation?
- Balance between parents' interests
- Relocation: yes!
- Re-aligning visitation: no?
