

## 3rd International Surrogacy Forum, 24 & 25 March 2025 - Cape Town, South Africa





After the successes of the first (Cambridge, 2019) and second (Copenhagen, 2023) Forum, the **Nordic Centre for Comparative and International Family Law** (NorFam) is proud to continue the trend of conferences in cities beginning with a 'C'. The 3<sup>rd</sup> International Surrogacy Forum will take place in Cape Town, South Africa! As previously, it will be co-organised by the **International Academic of Family Lawyers** (IAFL) and the **American Bar Association** (ABA) **Section of Family Law** of the, who will be joined by the Law Faculty of the <u>University of the Western Cape</u> and the leading South African law firm <u>Miller du Toit Cloete Incorporated</u>.

The venue is the gorgeous <u>The President Hotel</u>, located in the wonderful Bantry Bay area of Cape Town.
