



IAFL Supplementary Information for USA Chapter Admissions

Significant weight is given to applicants who are Fellows in the AAML;

It will then be one of these two points:

An applicant from a state which has a specialist family law accreditation is not eligible for fellowship unless they have the accreditation.

Or

If an applicant is from a state which has a specialist family law accreditation, accreditation of the applicant is given significant weight, and it is a presumption to be overcome if an applicant does not have the accreditation;

Applications may be deferred for further investigation if no one serving on the Admissions Committee knows the reference or if the reference is not adequately specific about the personal knowledge of the applicant or the international components of the applicant's practice.

International experience includes, but is not limited to, Hague cases, jurisdictional disputes, custody and visitation matters which include international issues and property matters where one or more of the parties hold property in jurisdictions outside of the USA.
